Solid Waste Program Update – 2022



Dear Fraser Township Resident,

At the May 11, 2022 Council meeting, the Fraser council approved a new five (5) year agreement with GFL Environmental USA INC. (GFL) as the township's new solid waste provider. The first service day is Friday July 8, 2022, Due to Holiday. GFL will be responsible for the curbside collection of household waste, large bulk waste, recyclables, and seasonal yard waste. HOUSEHOLD SOLID WASTE, RECYCLING, BULK WASTE COLLECTION AND SEASONAL YARD WASTE COLLECTION
STARTING JULY 1st, YOUR REGULAR SERVICE
DAY IS **THURSDAY.**

All items for pickup (including trash, recycling, bulk and yard waste) must be out by 7am on day of service.

HOUSEHOLD SOLID WASTE

Please place household solid waste out in your 95-gallon plastic containers, 3-4 feet from mailboxes, trees, shrubs, vehicles or other obstructions by 7am on day of service.

To provide a safe environment in every neighborhood, please remove containers from the collection point as soon as possible following collection. To eliminate spillage and possible injury, please do not overload containers. Should you place out for collection 95-gallon plastic containers, weight limit should not exceed 60 pounds, container and contents. Weight limit on plastic bags should not exceed the manufacturer's recommendations.

BULKY WASTE-APPLIANCES & FURNITURE

The collection of large bulky waste, such as appliances and furniture, will continue to be part of your solid waste program. You may set out large bulky items on your regular scheduled service day for collection. No need to call or schedule pickup. Please place large bulky items out separate from other products for collection and have out by 7am on day of service. Large items may include: washers, dryers, freezers, refrigerators, air conditioners, hot water tanks, stoves, microwaves, couches, chairs, tables, dressers and other large items.

FYI: Please remove the doors and racks from refrigerators and freezers prior to setting out for collection. The Freon must be removed by certified cooling company. Please affix the certification sticker to each appliance.
